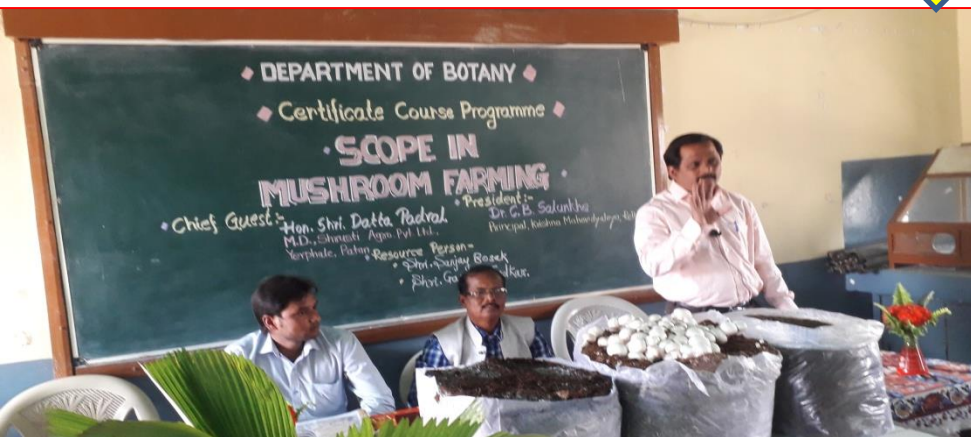
All the teaching and non teaching staff of Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare Bk. worked cordially for the success of this workshop.

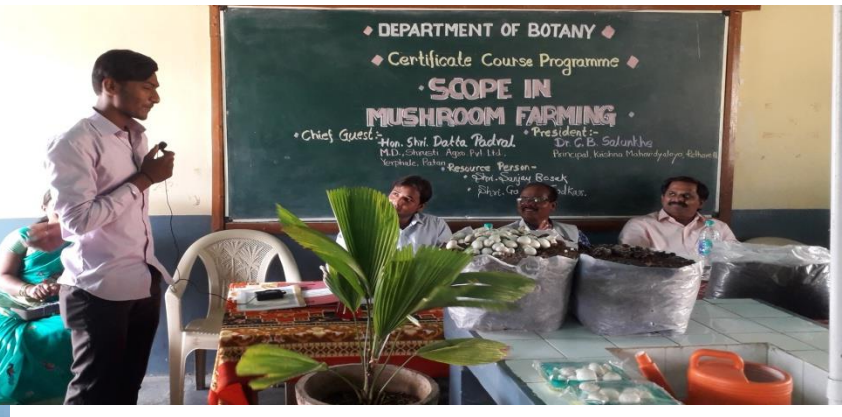
