'Challenges in Teaching Compulsory English in covid-19 situation'
27th August 2020

A one day national seminar on "Challenges in Teaching Compulsory English in COVID-19 Situation" was held in Krishna Mahavidyalaya Rethare BK, Taluka Karad, Dist- Satara, Maharashtra state, jointly organized by the Department of English and the IQAC cell of the college on 27th August 2020. The IQAC Coordinator and Head of the Physics department Dr. Dhanaji Suresh Dalavi inaugurated the seminar. The Head of the English department and the Convener of the national seminar Mr. Suresh Telvekar expressed vote of thanks and also give an introductory speech on the seminar. In his speech he expressed the objectives of the seminar and expected possible remedies on challenges in teaching compulsory English in covid-19 situation during the seminar from the invited speakers. Mrs. Yadav proposed vote of thanks for both the Co-ordinator and the head of the English department.

Total 101participants responded through the feedback form in the e- seminar and their certificates of participation were issued to their e-mails. He also gave information about the advent of compulsory English and also the communication skills in colleges and talked about the existing problems in teaching compulsory English in large classes, the problem of attention of students, their negative attitude and also the real challenges in teaching English compulsory in covid-19 situation. He also expressed his views on the mentality of the students and their inability to attend the classes online because of the lack of network problem and also the lack of proper exposure to English. He gave detailed explanation and suggestions regarding various educational apps, videos on YouTube and other methods by which the problem of teaching English can be solved. He even suggested to minimize the classroom strength and also to take lectures in shifts.

Mr. Santosh Ambavade expressed vote of thanks and also introduced the second Invited Speaker Dr. Neelkanth Jagannath Dahale from Mahatma Phule Mahavidyalaya, Pune. Dr Dahale gave an informative speech on the interview techniques in covid-19 situation. He gave detailed information and suggestion regarding the preparation of the interviews, filing of documents, mental preparation before going to the interview, how to dress, body language and need of politeness. He even suggested number of things regarding the type of situation at the interview cabin, the type of language needed and how to create a favourable impression on the interviewers.
