Report of the Workshop

Incubation centre and IQAC, Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare Bk. Organized National Workshop on Agrobusiness opportunities in Biosciences on 1st February to 5th February 2021. The workshop was sponsored by UGC-PARAMARSH Scheme. Total 700+ participants (online/offline) have registered for this workshop. Participants included farmers, engineers, academicians, researchers, faculty members, president and members of self-help groups and students.

Context of the Workshop:

Virtual state level workshop on 'Agrobusiness Opportunities in Biosciences' is envisaged to provide an opportunity for the farmers, students and faculty members from various colleges to know the various agricultural supplement business opportunities related to biosciences. The main focus of workshop is to provide detailed scientific and technical information on agro-business opportunities through expert views to inculcate scientific temper about said opportunities among farmers and students. The topics such as seed production technology, Food processing technology, Vermicomposting, Mushroom farming, Spirulina farming and apiculture is covered in the said workshop. The workshop is organized to encourage farmers to consider and adopt new practices in agriculture and to build some entrepreneurial skills in participant farmers and students as well as this workshop will give platform to farmers to interact with experts and share their views and ideas and experiences.

The overall objective of this workshop is to help the farming community in the development of agro-business by technical guidance and importing practical trainings.

Day 1: 1st February 2021

Inauguration Function

Dr. S. H. Jadhav, Convener and Chairman of Incubation Centre presented the theme of the workshop. Dr. C. B. Salunkhe, Principal of Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare presided over the inauguration function. He briefly introduced the theme of workshop, mission, vision and activities of Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare. Dr. M. M. Rajmane, Principal of Sadguru Gadage Maharaj College and chief guest for the Workshop appreciated the efforts of Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare and their appropriateness of the

Day 2: 2nd February 2021

Session 1: Spirulina Farming

Mr. Siddhant S. Jadhav, Managing Director, Geeta-Maruti Natural Foods, Islampur, Dist. Sangli given speech on Spirulina Farming. He discussed spirulina cultivation strategies, spirulina tablet formation, its marketing and extraction of other compounds from spirulina in detail.

Session 2: Mushroom Farming

Resource person of second session was Dr. A. K. Mali, Mushroom grower and Principal of Krishitantra Vidyalaya, Adwad, Jalgaon. He discussed nutritive qualities and health benefits of mushroom, cultivation of

oyster mushroom, value added products of mushroom, harvesting and packaging of mushroom and its marketing strategies.

Session 1: Seed Production Technology

In the first session Dr. N. B. Malekar has given the talk on 'Seed Production Technology'. He shared his experience about various crop seed production technology.

Session 2: Microgreens: Superfood

Dr. S. H. Jadhav, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare Bk., discussed concept of microgreens, its health benefits, growing of microgreens, safety precautions while consuming microgreens and business opportunities.


