Policy Document of Scholarship and Freeship

Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare Bk is a grant-in-aid college recognized under UGC 1 (f) and 12 (B) affiliated to the Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The Institute follows the rules and regulations of state and central government for government scholarships and Freeship to the students.

The Mission of Shetkari Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's (Governing Body of Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare BK) is to make higher education accessible to socially weaker students as well as meritorious students in academics as well as sports. As a part of the Mission, our college provides various scholarships, and incentives to the students of economically weaker sections of society as well as to the sports, cultural, and NCC students on the basis of their academic performance. The applications are invited from the students and it is scrutinized and verified by the concerned committee and the amount of scholarship/incentives disbursed to the students.

There are six types of rewards/scholarships/incentives for students.

1. Student Aid Fund (SAF)

The SAF scheme is initiated by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The main objective of this scheme is to give support to the students of economically weaker sections of society to get an opportunity for higher education. For the said scheme, applications are invited from the students along with all necessary documents. The applications and documents are scrutinized and verified by the committee. The list of eligible candidates will be approved by the concerned committee and authority. Finally, the amount will be disbursed to eligible candidates.

2. Earn and Learn Scheme.

The main objective of this scheme is to develop students as multifaceted personalities with academic excellence and commitment to a democratic society. This scheme is basically undertaken for the benefit of students from poor and economically weaker families. The applications are invited from the student and shortlisted students get opportunities to work in the college office, library and laboratory. The students will get an amount of Rs. 30/- for one hour and a maximum up to 3 hrs in a day and 3 days in a week.

3. Scholarship/Incentives to sports students.

This scheme is mainly implemented for the sports students whose performance is outstanding at college, university, zonal, interzonal, state, and national levels. The applications are invited from the students along with all necessary



documents which are required for the scheme. The applications and documents are scrutinized and verified by the committee. The list of eligible candidates will be approved by the concerned committee and authority. Finally, the amount will be disbursed to eligible candidates.

4. Admission fee concessions for economically weaker students.

The students who cannot afford to pay their fees and are in ominous need of the concession of fees apply for the concession in fees. The applicant requests the concession in tuition fees along with the reason for the concession. The application is forwarded to the Management of the College and the concession is granted to the applicant.

5. TA/DA allowances to attend seminars/conferences and workshops.


The scheme is mainly implemented for the students to attend seminars/conferences/workshops and Avishkar events at nearby colleges and at the university. The applications are invited from the students along with all necessary documents which are required for the scheme. The applications and documents are scrutinized and verified by the committee. The list of eligible candidates will be approved by the concerned committee and authority. Finally, the amount will be disbursed to eligible candidates.

6. Concession for Payment of fees in two installments.

The college is located in a rural area. Some students have no capacity to pay an admission fee in one installment. The college has initiated a scheme to pay a fee in two installments for the students who are unable to pay a fee in one installment. The applications and undertaking are taken from the students for the next installment.
